Concert Choir

- The Concert Choir led by Artistic Director Vincent Mingils, is an advanced level ensemble designed for singers, fifth through eighth grades, with prior musical and choral experience. This choir is demanding in terms of music difficulty, time commitments, and individual responsibility. Singers placed in this choir understand the necessity of balancing other extra-curricular activities with the demands of this choir's rehearsal and performance schedule.
- Rehearsals are twice per week on Mondays and Wednesdays form 6:00 P.M. to 7:15 P.M.
- Singers are committed to sing the entire concert season. This includes four major performances and any additional performances that may be scheduled throughout the year.
- Concert Choir tours are biennial and singers in this group are expected to travel with the choir. Numerous fundraising activities occur throughout the year and can help offset travel costs.
- Tuition for Concert Choir is \$300 and is due by Oct. 1 (see page 1 for information) Payment options are available. Tuition may be paid by one payment or four postdated checks Oct. 1, Nov. 1, Dec.1, Jan. 1. ACCC can also accept cash or credit card when paying entire amount (a 3% fee will be added for usage of credit card) ACCC is aware that this is a very difficult time for some of our families. ACCC will still need to charge tuition for next year but we are very willing to work with our families if needed to extend payments over more than four months or delay the start of payments until December or January if necessary. Please do not let finances influence your decision.
- Concert Choir singers will need to provide black Lands End chino performance pants and black soft-soled shoes and black calf length socks. All other uniform pieces are provided by ACCC.

Lyric Choir

- Lyric Choir is a beginning level choir that helps to lay the foundation of vocal technique and musicianship. These motivated singers in fourth through seventh grades are led by Debbie Mathews. Singers placed in this choir show the ability to match pitch, hold basic parts, exhibit the maturity to focus, and listen well.
- Rehearsals are twice per week on Mondays and Wednesdays form 4:45 P.M. to 5:45 P.M.
- Singers are committed to sing the entire concert season. This includes four major performances and any additional performances that may be scheduled throughout the year.
- Tuition for Lyric Choir is \$250 and is due Oct. 1 (see page 1 for information) Payment options are available. Tuition may be paid by one payment or four postdated checks Oct. 1, Nov. 1, Dec.1, Jan. 1. ACCC can also accept cash or credit card when paying entire amount (a 3% fee will be added for use of credit card) ACCC is aware that this is a very difficult time for some of our families. ACCC will still need to charge tuition for next year but we are very willing to work with our families if needed to extend payments over more than four months or delay the start of payments until December or January if necessary.
