Audition Information

- **Eligible students** - 4th - 8th graders in the fall of 2022
- **Audition Appointment** is needed - audition runs 5 minutes - call for a time – 307-638-1435
- **Audition Dates: Tuesday, May 10th Thursday, May 12th Friday, May 13th**
 5 minute audition time blocks from 4:15 AM – 5:45 PM
- **To Schedule an Audition call: 307-638-1435**
 Please call between 9:00 AM – 4:00 PM (leave message with your number and we will return your call)
 Please schedule an audition time by Friday, May 6
- **Audition Fee: \$20 (due at the audition)** Students not accepted into ACCC will have their Audition Fee returned
- **Tuition Assistance** (See Tuition Fees on the back) Assistance is available to families eligible for free and reduced lunches. ACCC is committed to seeing that every child wishing to participate in this program is able to do so. Please request an application via email (maryann.fritz@laramie1.org) and bring to the audition.

Audition Requirements

- **Singers will be asked to sing** “America the Beautiful”, a major scale, echo sing melodic patterns, and “Are You Sleeping”.
- **Parents are asked** to attend with the singer to fill out audition forms and pay the Audition Fee. Parents ARE NOT allowed to sit in on the individual auditions but will have a chance to learn about the choir program and ask questions.

Additional Audition Information

- **Audition Location:** Storey Gym Music Room - 2811 House Ave. - Please enter off of Evans Avenue on the east side of Storey Gym through Door #8. Follow the signs!
- **Choir Placement:** This is determined by the student’s audition, grade level, and choral experience. Please read the Choir Information on the reverse side.
- **Notification:** Audition results will be sent to parents via mail. If you do not receive notification by May 20th, please e-mail maryann.fritz@laramie1.org.

Concert Choir

- The Concert Choir led by Artistic Director Vincent Mingils, is an advanced level ensemble designed for singers, fifth through eighth grades, with prior musical and choral experience. This choir is demanding in terms of music difficulty, time commitments, and individual responsibility. Singers placed in this choir understand the necessity of balancing other extra-curricular activities with the demands of this choir's rehearsal and performance schedule.
- Rehearsals are twice per week on Mondays and Wednesdays from 5:30 P.M. to 7:00 P.M.
- Singers are committed to sing the entire concert season. This includes four major performances and any additional performances that may be scheduled throughout the year.
- Concert Choir tours are biennial and singers in this group are expected to travel with the choir. Numerous fundraising activities occur throughout the year and can help offset travel costs.
- Tuition for Concert Choir is \$300 and is due at the required registration meeting (see reverse side for information) Payment options are available.
- Concert Choir singers will need to provide black Lands End chino performance pants and black soft-soled shoes and black calf length socks. All other uniform pieces are provided by ACCC.

Lyric Choir

- Lyric Choir is a beginning level choir that helps to lay the foundation of vocal technique and musicianship. These motivated singers in fourth through seventh grades are led by Debbie Mathews. Singers placed in this choir show the ability to match pitch, hold basic parts, exhibit the maturity to focus, and listen well.
- Rehearsals are twice per week on Mondays and Wednesdays from 4:45 P.M. to 6:00 P.M.
- Singers are committed to sing the entire concert season. This includes four major performances and any additional performances that may be scheduled throughout the year.
- Tuition for Lyric Choir is \$250 and is due at the required registration meeting (see reverse side for information) Payment options are available.
- Lyric Choir singers will need to provide black Lands End chino performance pants and black soft-soled shoes and black calf length socks. All other uniform pieces are provided by ACCC.
